

Author guidelines

Basic information

The paper must include a title, keywords, and an abstract in English.

The rest of the paper can be presented in English, Italian or Spanish.

All papers must follow the conference Paper Template. The **FORTMED2027_paper_template** is available in the section “Paper Submission” at the page https://www.fortmed.eu/papers_eng.html

Two types of paper will be accepted:

- **Full Paper**: 8 pages, including images, endnotes and references.
- **Short paper**: 4 pages, including images, endnotes and references.

Paper delivery and review process

Papers will be sent by e-mail to: fortmed2027@upv.es

The e-mail must contain two attachments:

- 1) A complete **Word file** (.doc or .docx) - **paper**
- 2) An **Adobe Acrobat file** (.pdf) without personal data - **blind paper**

Files must be named using the **submission reference assigned** to this paper (e.g. 542-RODRIGUEZ.docx, 542-RODRIGUEZ.pdf)

You can send attachments of up to 10 Mb in a single e-mail. If the documents take up more space, send them using a download link WeTransfer, Jumbo mail or similar, checking first that it has NOT access password.

The Scientific Committee will conduct a blind peer review, determining the acceptance or rejection of papers. In any case, the facts justifying exclusion or requests for modification will be sent for **final approval**.

All duly accepted papers will be published in the Conference proceedings with an ISBN, provided that the registration fee has been paid by at least one author for each paper.

Submissions received after the deadline may not be included in the Conference proceedings.

For the drafting of the text

- 1- Do not insert images on the first page;
- 2- Insert images .jpg (CMYK) with resolution 300 dpi (300 ppp), and inserted in line with the text (not as a floating element);
 - * 1 column, 62.5 mm image. Wide;
 - * Overall width (2 columns), 133 mm image; Overall width images must be placed at the top or bottom of the page.
- 3- Do not insert footnotes. In case it is necessary, include final notes;
- 4- Use the Paper Template for formatting the References (*Harvard Style*). Examples are provided in the References section of the template.
- 5- Insert references in the text between parentheses with the surname and the year. Example (Coscollá, 2005) (Coscollá, 2005, pp. 20-21);
- 6- Respect the general template setting **strictly**. Do not modify any formatting features of the paper template. Please preserve the specified font types and sizes, line spacing, paragraph spacing, margins, and overall layout.
- 7- Authors are requested to consult the sample paper provided in order to check the required format before submission.
